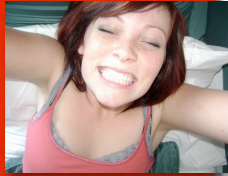


Faculty

Join us for three weeks of fun, excitement, learning, and musical theater! We will start by exploring the show and learning skills for auditioning for musical theater. From there we'll spend our days in rehearsals and workshops, learning various skills needed in a musical theater production including acting, singing, and dancing (THE TRIPLE THREAT) as well as costumes, makeup, set design, lighting, etc. Our camp will culminate in 3 live performances for the public, and thunderous applause!

Our program is unique in several ways. First of all, we will have **interactive, age-appropriate classes for kids of all ages**, from 6-18. Smaller children will get to spend time exploring theater basics in a fun, light-hearted atmosphere, while young adults will get a more challenging, exciting set of classes.

Three Tracks

Kids and parents can choose what they want to do during our time together!

Superstar Track - This track is for the kids who want to be on stage. They will get the chance to audition and play a part in a role or the chorus of the show! The majority of their camp time will be spent in rehearsal.

Behind The Scenes Track - This track is for kids who want to learn about musical theater, but don't necessarily want to appear on stage, as well as kids who have talent in the visual arts. They'll be focusing on costumes, sets, lighting, sound, and stage management.

Camper Track - if your family has a conflict during required performance times, you can still be a part of our camp and benefit from all the activities, classes, and interaction. Ask us about the camper track!
